

Changes to Sailing Instructions.

## **Number 1:**

SI 5 (Racing schedule) is amended as follows:

- a) The entry for racing on the 23<sup>rd</sup> February is replaced with:

Date	HW/Ht	Races Scheduled	Briefing	First Signal
23 <sup>rd</sup> February	1131/4.5	5, 6 and 7	0930	1025

- b) The final sentence of SI 5.1 is replaced with:

“Warning signals for the medium and slow handicap fleets should sound three and six minutes respectively after the fast handicap fleet’s warning signal, subject to there being no general recalls.”

## **Number 2:**

SI 14 (The Start) is amended as follows:

Add SI 14.4:

- 14.4 The starting procedure for all races will use the same sequence as Rule 26 with the following changes to the times. This changes Rule 26.

At 5 minutes before the first start the orange flag will be displayed on the committee boat. If an Answering Pennant (AP), or 1<sup>st</sup> Sub are displayed, these will be removed at 4 minutes.

3	Warning	Class Flag Displayed
2	Preparatory	P, I, Z, Z with I, U, or black flag
1	Preparatory removed	
0	Start	Class flag removed, and next class flag hoisted if there is another class to start
